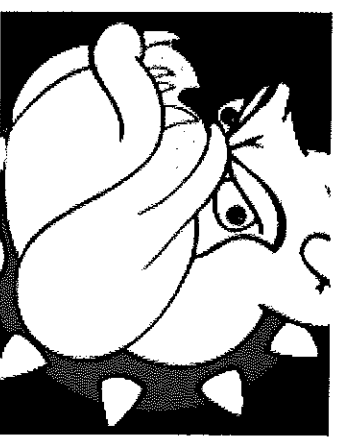

## District Goals

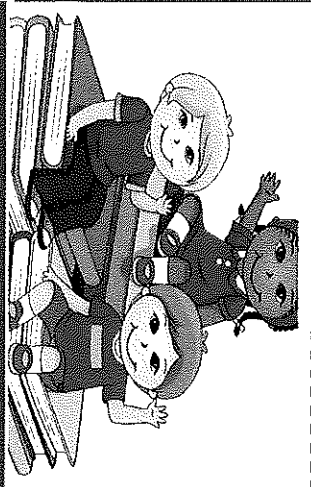
The Macon County Board of Education will increase the percentage of student scoring proficient or distinguished learners on the GA Milestones Mathematics Test by 3%.

- Teach parents to monitor student progress in ELA and math using Infinite Campus Parent Portal

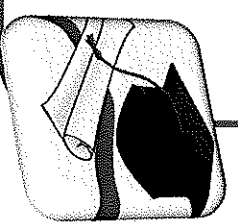
## At home,

- Make informed decisions, set goals, and take action to meet grade level requirements to help me prepare for my high school graduations



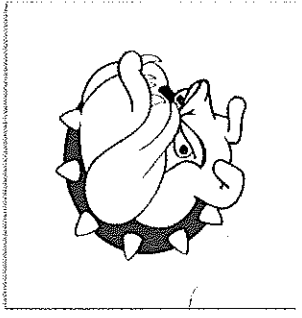
