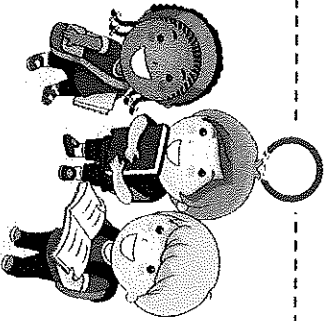
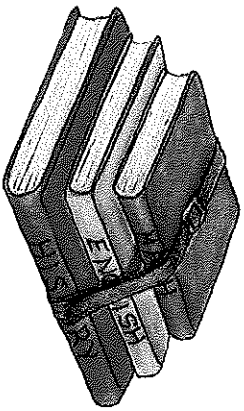
District Goals

At home,

Macon County Middle School students will:

- Deliver to my parents all papers, notes, and invitations to workshops that are sent home from school.
- Read at home at least 20 minutes per day and write a summary of what I read.
- Use math manipulatives/activities to practice math skills at home to reinforce the lessons that we are taught in school.
- Make informed decisions, set goals, and take action to meet grade level requirements to help me prepare for my high school graduations
