Title I, Part A is a Federally Funded program under the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). It is the largest federal program that the Macon County School System receives. The purpose of Title I under ESSA is to ensure that all students have a fair and equal opportunity to receive a quality education.

A large component of Title I, Part A is Parent and Family Engagement. Title I, Part A ensures that local school systems provide parents with information, notifications, and opportunities to have input in their child's education.

Title I, Part A ensures that students have high-quality assessments, curriculum, and academic supports. Title I, Part A supports supplemental instructional supplies and educational programs that school systems may not be able to provide with the federal program.
